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NESS SUB-DIVISION

185.Oct.23 FEHR: That in the matter of the proposed subdivision application Community Planning file # SUBD-001921-2023 Council table any decision on the application until such time suitability is determined through various studies and design is finalized. Therefore, Council requests additional time to respond to the subdivision referral from Community Planning branch. Council further advises of the following:

- A comprehensive development review shall be prepared by the proponent. The proponent is encouraged to contact the RM and its planner for details of required content.
- A servicing agreement would be required to address the construction of any required roadway, drainage works, or for any other matter under s. 172 of The Planning and Development Act, 2007, and the proponent would be responsible for all related costs.
- In accordance with its road classification policy, the RM requests a minimum width of road right-of-way to be 40 metres, and 46 metres for the turn around within any cul-de-sac. The plan of proposed subdivision is requested to be updated accordingly.
- Cash-in-lieu of municipal reserve is desired at a value of \$10k/acre. The current subdivision area is 31.66 ac. equating to a cash-in-lieu payment of \$31,660.
- Planning bylaw amendments to change land use designation and zoning, and potentially textual amendment(s) would be required. The proponent would be required to make application for all necessary amendments to the RM and pay any related fees in accordance with its Planning and Development Fee Bylaw. It is expected that this would be one of the last steps in the subdivision review process and upon finalization of subdivision design.
- The RM supports any requirement of the proponent to plan for and install any required utility service at the time of subdivision and that lots are adequately serviced in preparation for end development.
- The RM supports Community Planning requests of the proponent for studies related to: slope stability, drainage, hydrogeological conditions for water and waste water provision, heritage resource impact, utility installation, or any other matter which may arise in the subdivision review.
