#### SCHOLARSHIP'S HISTORY

In 1995, SARM auctioned off the first copy of its history book, "The Building of a Province: Commemorating the 90th Anniversary of the Saskatchewan Association of Rural Municipalities." This auction netted the sum of \$2,600 which the SARM Board of Directors contributed to the Canadian Centre for Health and Safety in Agriculture (CCHSA).

These funds initiated the Saskatchewan Association of Rural Municipalities 90th Anniversary
\$1,000 Student Scholarship in Agricultural Safety and Rural Health.

The National Partners Fund at CCHSA maintains the scholarship.

#### GENERAL CONDITIONS GOVERNING AWARD

- The winner will be announced in March and will be asked to attend the SARM convention to accept the award.
- Two \$1500 scholarships will be awarded to the students who submits the best farm safety essay accompanied by a completed application form.
- These awards are contingent upon the recipient proceeding to their first year of post secondary education in Saskatchewan. The student can be attending school outside of the province if the courses they want to take are not offered in Saskatchewan.
- 4. Students who misrepresent themselves will be eliminated from the essay competition.
